DIE-CUTTING LIST
There is no advance die-cutting required.

You can pre-cut strips of cardstock measuring $6 \times 1-7 / 8$, scoring in half at 3 , thus creating mini cards. You can diecut the front right edge of the card covers with the Half \& Half die featuring a point.
You can pre-cut the front 5-1/2 edge of all your white notecards with the Edgers \#4 die

You can pre-cut multiple sizes \& shapes of butterflies from various Pattern Pack papers, however, Dawn will be offering tips on how to pair up different patterns if you would like to wait and see her video before cutting.
You can pre-cut one Fillable Frames \#10 shape per card you are creating for your card set, using Pattern Pack polka-dot paper of your choice. Melissa also accents her cards with the Notched Flower dies, which you can pre-cut from various patterned papers.
