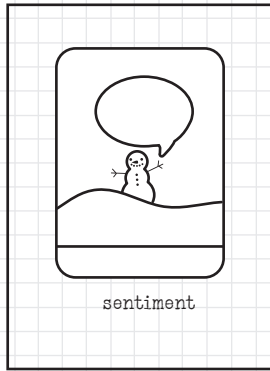

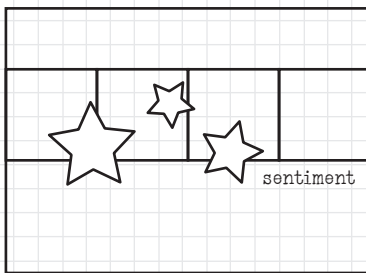


DESIGN NOTES:

Use a journaling card or cardstock block paired with some die-cut hills and a speech bubble to set the stage for a favorite character or animal stamp.

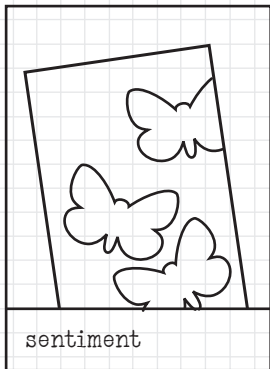


DESIGN NOTES:

choose four patterned papers cut down into squares to create a border on your card front. Add three die-cut shapes or embellishments randomly across border.

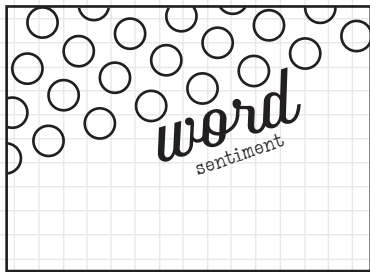


DESIGN NOTES:

Use strip of colored cardstock at bottom of card. Insert cardstock block at an angle.

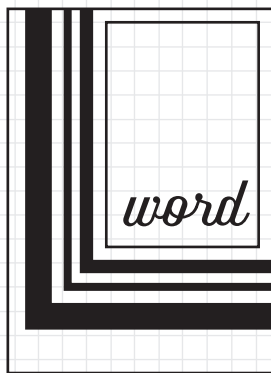


DESIGN NOTES:

Repeat a small die-cut shape in diagonal rows. Cut the shapes from chipboard or a few layers of cardstock to help add depth and texture. Keep it simple with a die-cut word and stamped companion sentiment.

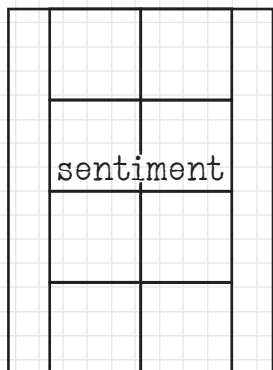


DESIGN NOTES:

Use a Text Block, Phrase Play or journaling card die with mitered borders of various widths.

DESIGN NOTES:

Use a 1-3/8" square punch with eight colors of cardstock. Adhere them in two rows on an A2 card front. Add any Keep It Simple sentiment across the center.
