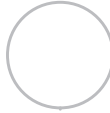

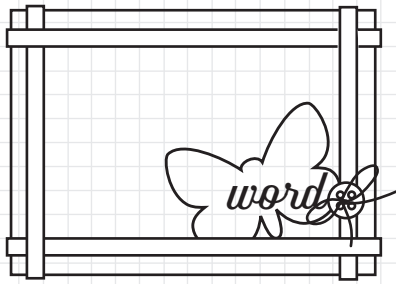

Sketch recipe

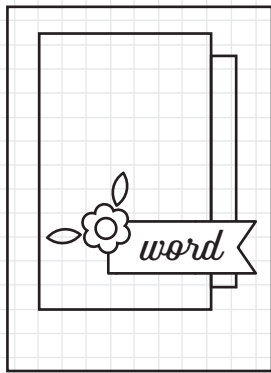


DESIGN NOTES:

Create a frame with thin strips of scrap paper. Accent the side with a button and twine. Stamp a sentiment and image to balance things out.

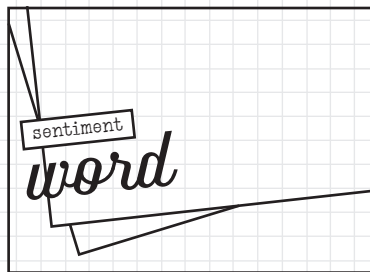


DESIGN NOTES:

Let a bit of pretty patterned paper peek out from under your card front. Balance the design with a sentiment banner and floral die-cut or embellishment.

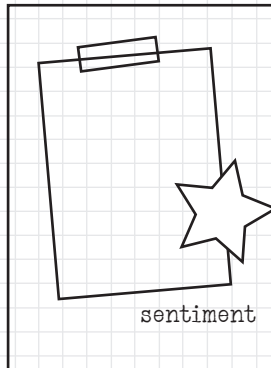


DESIGN NOTES:

Add two blocks of papers, at an angle and trim accordingly. Place a die cut word and stamped block sentiment on top using foam tape for dimension.

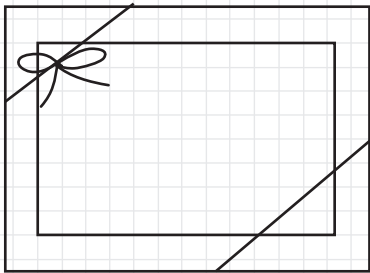
DESIGN NOTES:

Attach a block of cardstock to your card front at an angle using washi tape. Accent with a die-cut to the side to help balance the angle.

Stamp your sentiment directly onto the card front.

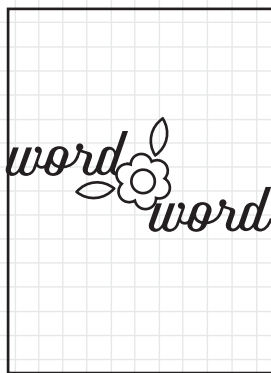


DESIGN NOTES:

After adding a card block to your card front, wrap twine around two corners at an angle and finish with a bow.
