






# Sketch recipe




#### DESIGN NOTES:

Stamp a large frame image onto your card base, allowing it to bleed off the edge. Use a block of text as your focal point. Highlight your preferred sentiment by heat embossing it on contrasting cardstock. Embellish with leaves, flowers, and sequins.

#### DESIGN NOTES:

Stamp a confetti background and sentiment onto a narrow card base Add a gift tag embellished with a bow Stamp a companion sentiment onto a die cut banner and adhere to the tag. Use small, glittered die cuts to add sparkle.




#### DESIGN NOTES:

Use a cover plate to give your card base tone-on-tone texture. Use a large, brightly colored floral image as your focal point. Adhere to your card base with foam adhesive for interest. Stamp sentiment directly on card base.




#### DESIGN NOTES:

Use layered banner die cuts to ground your sentiment and focal point. Create a birthday collage with numeral die cuts and celebratory images. Embellish with enamel dots to keep your design more masculine or use sequins for a feminine look.

#### DESIGN NOTES:

Create a unique background with blocks of text or other linear pattern. Use the pattern to draw attention to a focal point of layered watercolored flowers. Stamp a sentiment onto a die cut banner and tuck into the floral arrangement.

### Sketch recipe



#### DESIGN NOTES:

Stamp and watercolor a large floral image to use as a background. Heat emboss sentiment onto vellum and embellish with die cut frame. Adhere over floral bacground so that the image shows through. Add a simple twine bow as a finishing touch.
