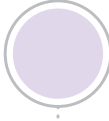

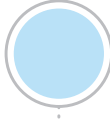

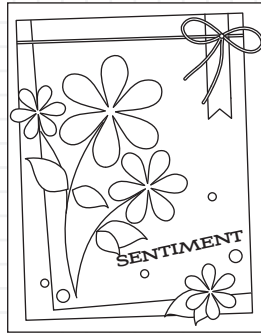

Sketch recipe

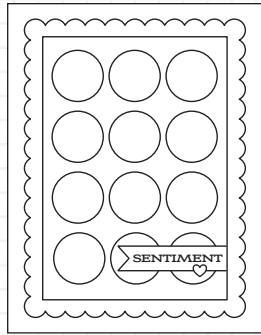


DESIGN NOTES:

Use a large blooming stem as the focal point of your card. A large sentiment will pair better than one on the smaller side. Use askew papers and cardstock for interest and add elements like a die cut banner, twine, and sequins or gems for sparkle.

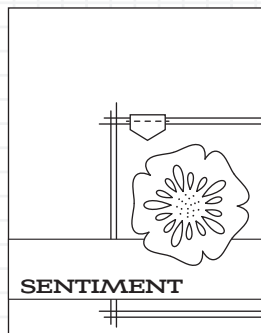


DESIGN NOTES:

Stamp a background using a single geometric image in a repeating pattern. Use a variety of ink colors to keep things interesting. Frame the arrangement with a die cut and add a sentiment on a simple banner. A tiny embellishment can tie it all together.

Sketch recipe

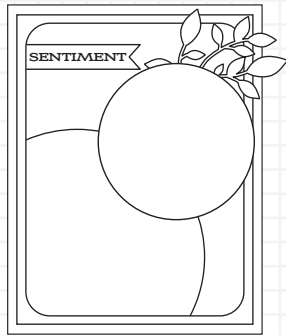


DESIGN NOTES:

Use a stamped frame and sentiment strip to ground an off-center focal point. Stitch on a small banner or tab for a companion sentiment or stamped image. Leave styling on the simple side for masculine cards or add embellishments for a feminine feel.

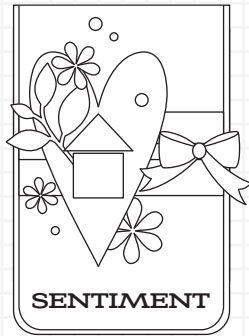


DESIGN NOTES:

Layer large stamped and die cut images to give a collage effect. Use dimensional adhesive, color, and texture to add depth. Tuck a leafy vellum branch in between layers to add lightness. Include stamped sentiment on a die cut banner.

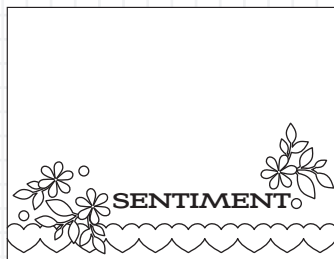


DESIGN NOTES:

Stamp a background and use patterned vellum to soften. Layer with patterned paper, ribbon, and large-scale die cuts. Add an assortment of leaves and flowers along with a die cut sentiment. Use sequins or gems to embellish.

DESIGN NOTES:

Stamp a large sentiment on a subtle background using a bold ink. Use a border strip to ground the greeting and then embellish with flowers and sprigs of foliage. Sprinkle on a few sequins or gems to add a touch of sparkle.
